2. The purpose of the Municipal Alliance Committee shall include, but not be limited to the following:

a. Organize and coordinate efforts involving school, law enforcement, business and community groups for the purpose of reducing alcoholism and drug abuse.

b. Develop, in conjunction with the LEA, comprehensive alcoholism and drug abuse education programs for grades K-12.

c. Develop, in conjunction with the LEA, procedures for intervention, treatment/referral and discipline of students involved with substance abuse.

d. Develop comprehensive alcoholism and drug abuse education, outreach and support efforts for parents.

e. Develop a comprehensive alcoholism and drug abuse community awareness program.

c. To identify existing efforts and services acting to reduce alcoholism and drug abuse.

d. To assist in the development of programs at the municipal level that accomplish the purpose of the Alliance effort.

e. To assist the municipality in acquiring funds for Alliance programs.

f. To cooperate with the Governor's Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse, as well as the County Alliance Committee to provide data, reports, or other information that may be needed to assist in the Alliance effort.

He thanked his wife and family for their support. He felt together they could all make Jackson a model community for the

entire State. He thanked the former Council members that weren't present for their time and dedication to Jackson.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT KAFTON stated it was a great day when dignitaries come to a small town like Jackson to welcome new members to the Council. He thanked his family for their support and his office staff adding that he's been an active member of Jackson for his entire life and is honored and humbled that he has been elected to public office four times with this election meaning the most. He is excited to begin this chapter that began with Democrats and Republicans running together for the good of the people. On the local level everyone is the same and undivided by party affiliation. He spoke of some ideas coming from the public and ways of looking outside the box to bring money into Jackson. He addressed the outstanding fines and all matters coming before the Council should have complete supporting documentation and projections prior to any action being taken.
