



FALL CURBSIDE LEAF SCHEDULE



It is important that all residents follow the directions listed below in order for the Dept. of Public Works to pick up your leaves in the most efficient manner.

All districts will have two (2) pickups between October 1st and December 31st 2009. Please refer to the schedule in this brochure for your district schedule. If you are not sure which district you reside in, please call 732-928-1311.

1. All leaves **must be placed loosely** at the curb or roads edge by 7:00 a.m. on the first date of your scheduled pickup. **(i.e., if pickup is Oct. 5-8 it must be out by 7:00 a.m. on the 5th, no later.)**
2. Do not place leaves too far into the roadway. This causes traffic obstruction and may be dangerous.
3. Do not place leaves in bags.
4. Do not mix brush or other debris with leaves. If you do so, your leaf pile will be deemed contaminated and will not be picked up.
5. Do not place leaves out **after** our crews have already been on your street. We will not return until the second scheduled pick up. Our GPS system can determine whether or not our crews have picked up in your area.
6. If a vehicle is blocking your leaf pile, the leaves will not be picked up nor will we return after you have moved the vehicle.
7. Leaf piles may not exceed 4' x 4' x 16'.
8. No leaves will be picked up at businesses, i.e. campgrounds.

Residents are encouraged to compost their leaves. Information on composting is available through:

Residents wanting to dispose of large amounts of leaves may do so at the **Jackson Township Vegetative Waste Transfer Facility**. The facility is located on Kierych Drive and is open Wednesday through Sunday, 7:00 a.m.—5:00 p.m. Bagged leaves may be brought to the compost site. However, the bags must be opened at the site upon disposal of leaves.

Commercial vehicles and vehicles with commercial plates or markings are strictly prohibited from using the facility.
