

**Jackson Township Commission for the Handicapped / Disabled**  
**Meeting of April 19, 2017**  
**Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 7:13 pm by Chairperson Kelly Consalvo followed by a flag salute.

**Karate** - Kelly received a price of \$2,392 for ten weeks for 15-20 clients. Lou Melograna will check with a friend who may volunteer to teach Karate.

**Spring Fling**- Valerie Joyce stated that 47 clients, 32 guests and 13 others attended the event. \$30 in donations were received. \$260.75 for Farley's \$178 for Shop Rite \$238.70 for Oriental Trading and Party Fair \$298.71 Total of \$1,219.05 was spend for the Spring Fling.
