

ORDINANCE 04-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, OCEAN COUNTY NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 103 ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE ONE OF TITLE 39 WITH VARIOUS TRAFFIC REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ROYAL WOODS II AND REGULATING THE USE OF SAID ROADWAYS, STREETS, DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING LOTS BY MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Al Harrison, President of A& M Construction Company, Inc. has, filed a written consent with the Township of Jackson, that the provisions of Subtitle One of Title 39 of the revised statutes of New Jersey be made applicable to the semi-public roads, streets, driveways and parking lots at Royal Woods II located in the Township of Jackson, County of Ocean and the following regulations shall be enforceable:

REGULATION(S):

1. Through Streets:

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the streets or parts of streets described are hereby designated as Through Streets. Stop signs shall be installed on the near right side of each street intersecting the Through Street except where Yield signs are provided for the designation:

The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as Through Streets. Stop signs shall be installed on the near right side of each street intersecting the through street except where Yield signs are provided for the designation.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Olivia Way	Entire Length

2. Stop Intersections:

Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-140, the intersections described are hereby designated as Stop Intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as provided therein:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Stop Signs On</u>
Olivia Way and Royal Woods Court	Royal Woods Court

3. Speed Limits:

A. The speed limit for both directions of travel on the following roadways are:

<u>Name of Roadway</u>	<u>M.P.H.</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Olivia Way	25	Entire Length
Royal Woods Court	25	Entire length

B. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits authorized by the Jackson Township Police Department in conjunction with the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation.

4. Tow-Away Zones:

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, and grassy area pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owners or operators expense.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That all signs, posts, or other necessary materials be installed and paid for by the applicant. All signing shall conform to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided for by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of this ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

Effect of Ordinance:

If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the Ordinance.

If any section, subsection, paragraph sentence of any part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
